1. Purpose

The 22nd ASEAN Regional Forum Heads of Defense Universities/Colleges/Institutions Meeting (22nd ARF HDUCIM) is designed to engage the senior leadership of participating defense universities, colleges, and institutions (DUCIs) in discussions covering many issues of mutual interest, primarily in the area of defense education and research, defense exchanges and international cooperation, and regional security. The forum is expected to contribute to greater trust within the region. The meeting will be co-chaired by the National Institute of Defense Studies (NIDS, Japan) and the SAFTI Military Institute (SAFTI MI, Singapore).

2. Key Areas for Discussion and Session Topics

In accordance with practices of past meetings, the 22nd ARF HDUCIM will feature three separate sessions, each of which will be devoted to one of the following three key areas. Each participating DUCI will be invited to make a 15-minute oral presentation in one of these sessions.

Emerging security challenges, capacity building, and international cooperation

This area of discussion aims to examine, for example, new security challenges emerging in the Asia Pacific, efforts to build capacity necessary to deal with them, and prospects for international cooperation in building capacity, including developing human resources.

b. Roles of defense universities, colleges, and institutions in fostering future strategic leaders

Discussions in this area will cover issues such as qualities required of strategic leaders of our armed forces, strategies and

methods for fostering leaders who are properly prepared for taking on larger leadership roles, as well as mutually reinforcing roles of education, research, and other missions conducted at DUCIs.

c. Building and enhancing partnerships in today's security environment This area of discussion will consider issues such as possible ways to build and enhance partnerships for fostering regional cooperation and stability, the role of DUCIs in enhancing partnerships among member countries, and the function of international exchanges in educational curricula at DUCIs.
