

Piracy & Armed Robbery Situation in 2016 - (ASIA) Total: 85 (5 piracy, 80 robberies) ✤<u>76</u> actual, <u>9</u> attempted ✤<u>Decrease</u> across all CATs (except CAT 1) ✤<u>13</u> x CAT 1 incidents Abduction of crew (10) (serious concern) \checkmark Hijack of ships for oil cargo (3)

STRAITS OF MALACCA AND SINGAPORE (SOMS)

Most Drastic Decrease 104 cases in 2015 to


- 2 cases in 2016 - Arrest of perpetrators
- Arrest or perpetrators
 Joint coordinated patrol & surveillance by littoral States

HIJACKING OF SHIPS FOR THEFT OF OIL CARGO

Decrease 12 cases in 2015 to <u>3 cases in 2016</u> - Commitment by littoral States to clamp down crime - Arrest of head of syndicates in 2015

PORTS/ANCHORAGES IN VIETNAM Decrease 27 cases in 2015 to 9 cases in 2016

Decrease 27 cases in 2015 to <u>9 cases in 2016</u> - Concerted efforts by Vietnamese authorities - Vigilance by master and crew





ReaAAP

Information Sharing Centre Compared to past 5 years :

- Lowest in overall number.
- 58% decrease compared to 2015

Areas contribute to decrease

- Marked improvement in the Straits of Malacca and Singapore (SOMS).
- Decrease in hijack of ships for oil cargo theft.
- Improvement at certain ports / anchorages.


Possible reasons for decrease :


- Commitment and co-ordinated efforts by littoral States led to land operations / arrests of perpetrators / head of syndicate (Kingpin).
- Implement tight port security measures.
- Vigilance and anti-piracy measures by crew.
