
Kuala Lumpur Transport Strategic Plan 2016-2025 An Overview

- Adopted by the 21st ASEAN Transport Ministers (ATM) Meeting in November 2015
- The KLTSP 2016-2025, outlines 30 specific goals, 78 actions and 221 milestones in the areas of **maritime transport**, air transport, land transport, sustainable transport and transport facilitation
- The strategic goal for the maritime transport is as follows:

Maritime Transport

• Establish an ASEAN Single Shipping Market and promote maritime safety, security and strategic economic corridors within ASEAN

Progress and Key Achievements in 2016

During the 22nd ATM last 17-18 November 2016 in Manila, Philippines, ASEAN Transport Ministers:

Maritime Transport

- took note of the progress of the operationalization of the ASEAN Roll-On Roll-Off (RO-RO) Shipping Network
- adopted the Framework of Cooperation on Certification of Competency for Near Coastal Voyages (NCV) issued by ASEAN Member States





Progress and Key Achievements in 2016

During the 22nd ATM last 17-18 November 2016 in Manila, Philippines, ASEAN Transport Ministers:

Maritime Transport

- adopted the revised Strategic Plan for ASEAN-China Transport Cooperation
- adopted the Development Strategy for ASEAN-China Transport Scientific and Technological Cooperation
- endorsed the ASEAN-Japan Transport Partnership Work Plan for 2016-2017, which included the new Regional Action Plan on Port Security 2017, containing concepts of ASEAN models of the Audit Training Programme and Maritime Security Training of Trainers (ToT) Programme
- ▶ looked forward to the finalisation of the New ASEAN-ROK Transport Cooperation Roadmap 2018-2021
