# **NS in Singapore**

- Full-time National Service (NS)
   began in 1967
- Our national servicemen form the core of an operationally-ready SAF
- The SAF is fundamentally a citizenbased armed forces

# **Full-Time NS**

- 2 years of progressive training
- Comprises Basic Military Training, vocational training/command school training, and unit training
- Holistic training to develop physically strong and psychologically resilient servicemen
- More recently, pre-enlistees have been able to indicate interest in vocations










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# **Operationally Ready NS (ORNS)**



#### **Types of Training:**

- Low Key training (up to 6 days)
- High Key training (7 days or more)

Annual Individual Physical Proficiency Test (IPPT) Mobilisation Response Rate has been consistently high

#### Optimising Deployment of our National Servicemen

- Expanded roles for national servicemen to take on greater responsibilities and higher positions of command in the SAF
- For instance, the Republic of Singapore Navy deploys warships completely run by national servicemen
- Optimising time spent during ICT and overseas deployment of national servicemen for military exercises







### **Tackling New and Complex Threats**

- "3<sup>rd</sup> Generation SAF"- training of national servicemen has continually evolved to tackle new and complex threats
- National servicemen are trained in peacetime contingency operation roles to support our regular force in counter-terrorism efforts
- Expanding the SAF's operational capabilities in niche expertise areas through the Expertise Conversion Scheme (ECS)
