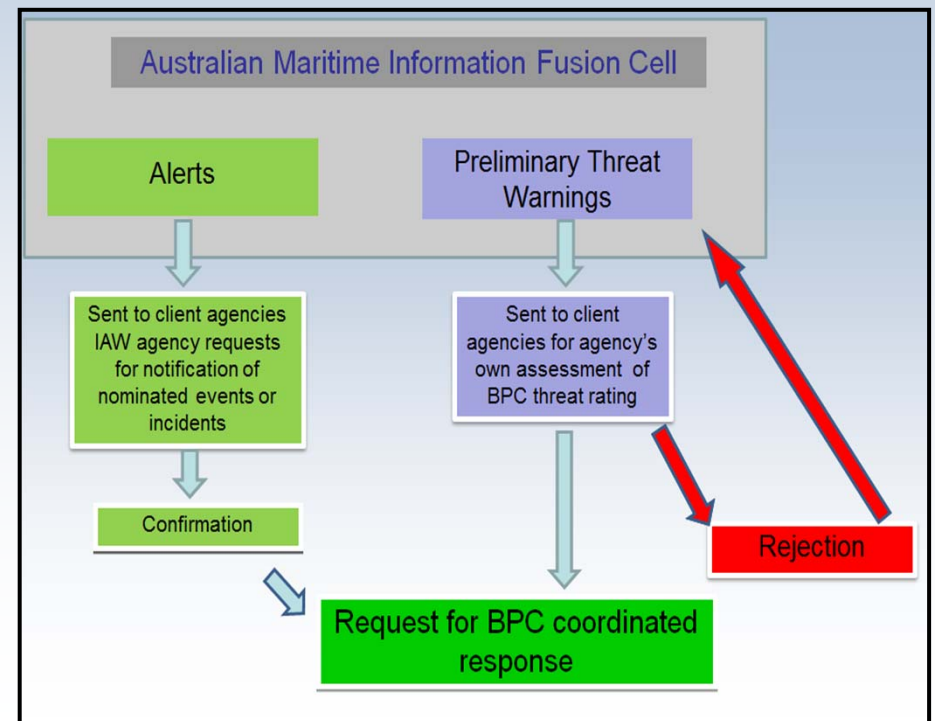




Australian Maritime Information System (AMIS)

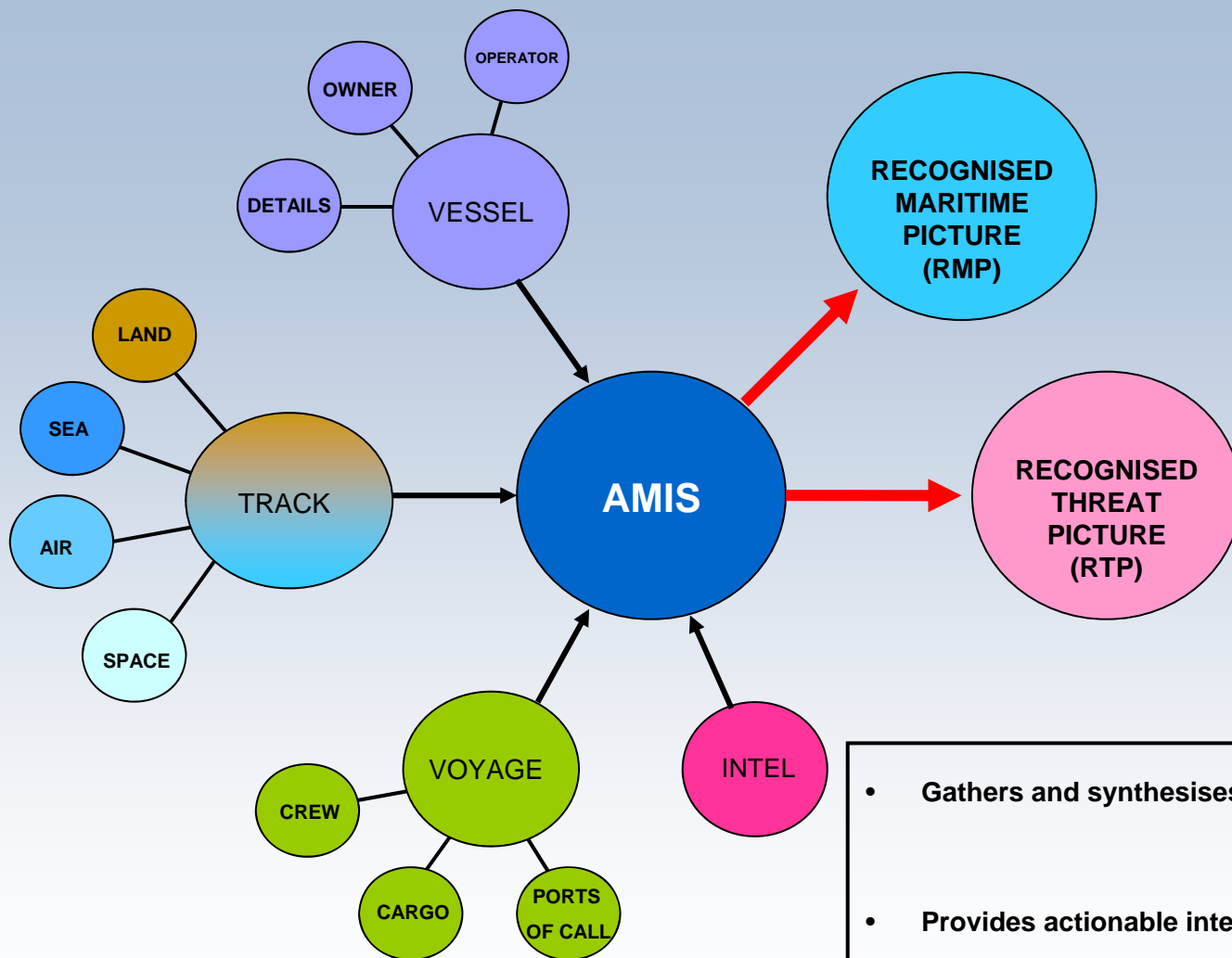


- Gathers and synthesises large amounts of information and brings together existing yet dispersed maritime data;
