Gaps in practices and principles/ SAR and Rules of the road

- No region wide center/ institutes
- Insufficient coordination between national agencies(including civil/military relations)
- Lack of mechanisms to enable sharing of technology
- Some existing networks have different levels of autonomy in SAR operations

- Insufficient knowledge of the rules by fishing communities
- Rules too complex for laymen/ Lack of CUES equivalent for civilian maritime agencies
- Language barriers
- Deliberate non-compliance
- Different organization framework at government level

Activities to address the gaps

- Ratification and implementation international rules /Capacity building
 Implement the concepts under the ARF statement on SAR
- Simplified and regionally customized rules of the road
- Training/ Education /Community outreach/
- Create a region wide center for sharing best practices and capacity building for better coordination on a nation to nation level;
- Network of experts/facilitate communication/Workshop or table top exercise for SAR;
- Standardized operating procedures/ Sign bilateral/ multilateral agreements on SAR cooperation
