4. Investigation of how and why *Rena* grounded

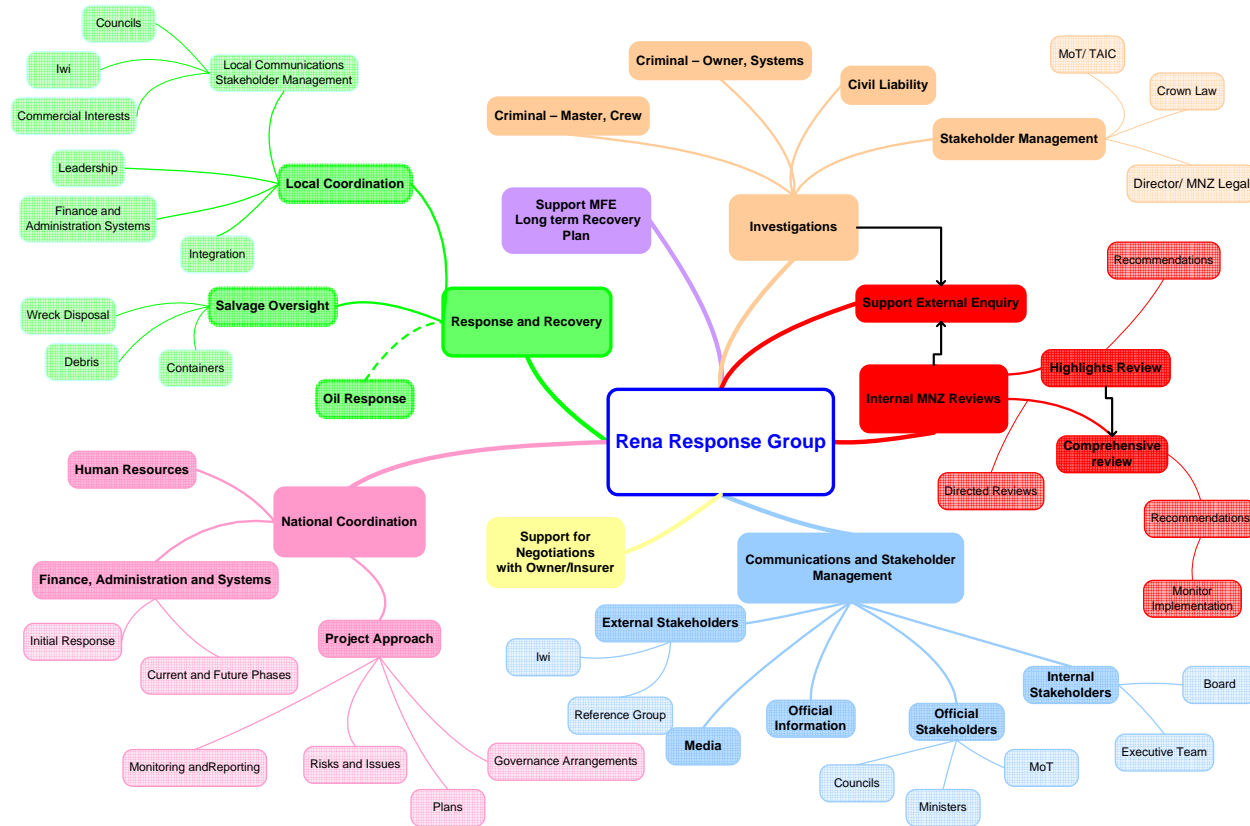
