Definition of CIMIC

Coordination and cooperation in support of the mission between military commander and civil population including national and local authorities as well as international, national and non-governmental organizations and agencies.



Components of Peace Operations

- **Military forces**
- **Humanitarian Organizations : IO, NGO**
- **Host nation**
- **Donor organizations and Media**

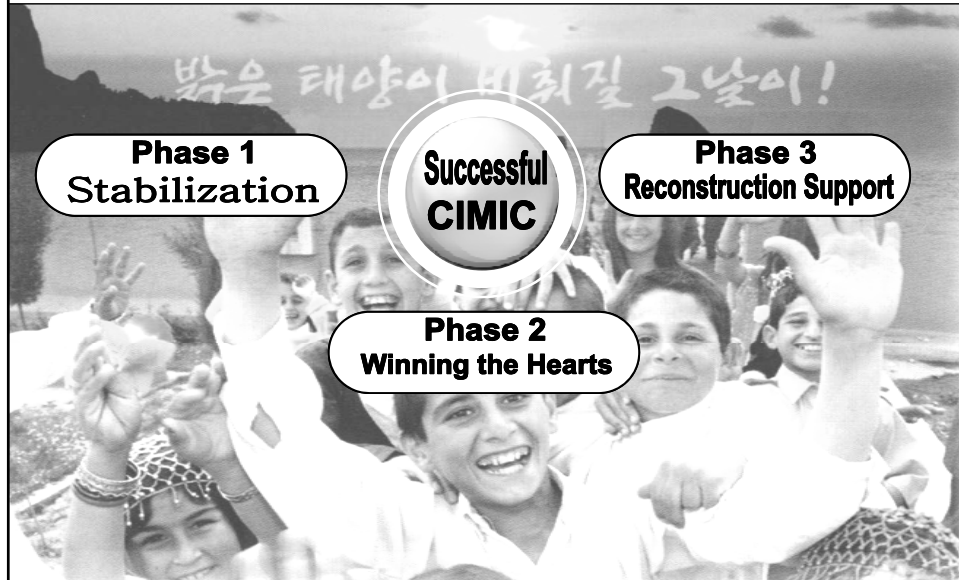

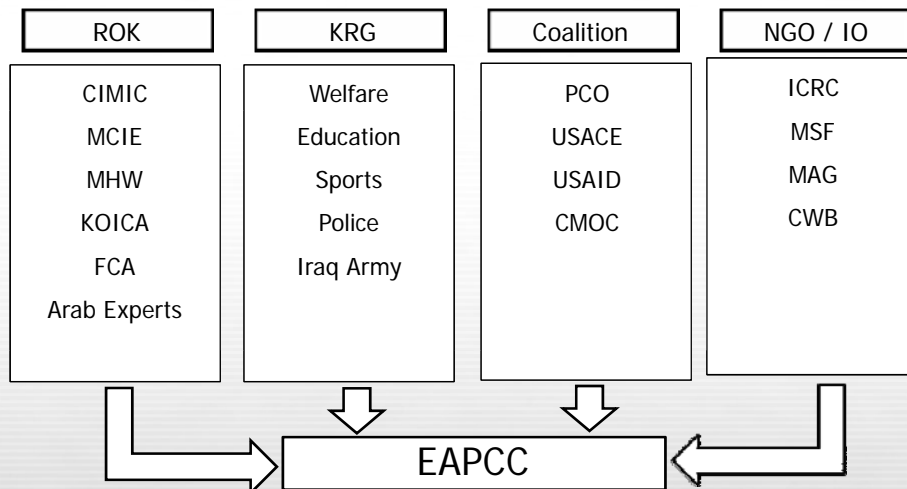

Organizations of CIMIC



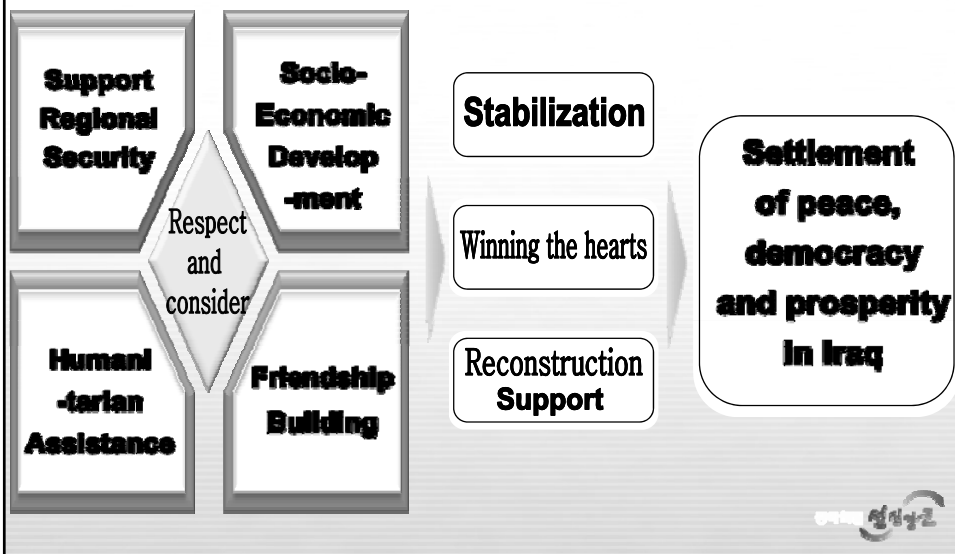
Build Coord. System on a Periodic / Rolling Basis

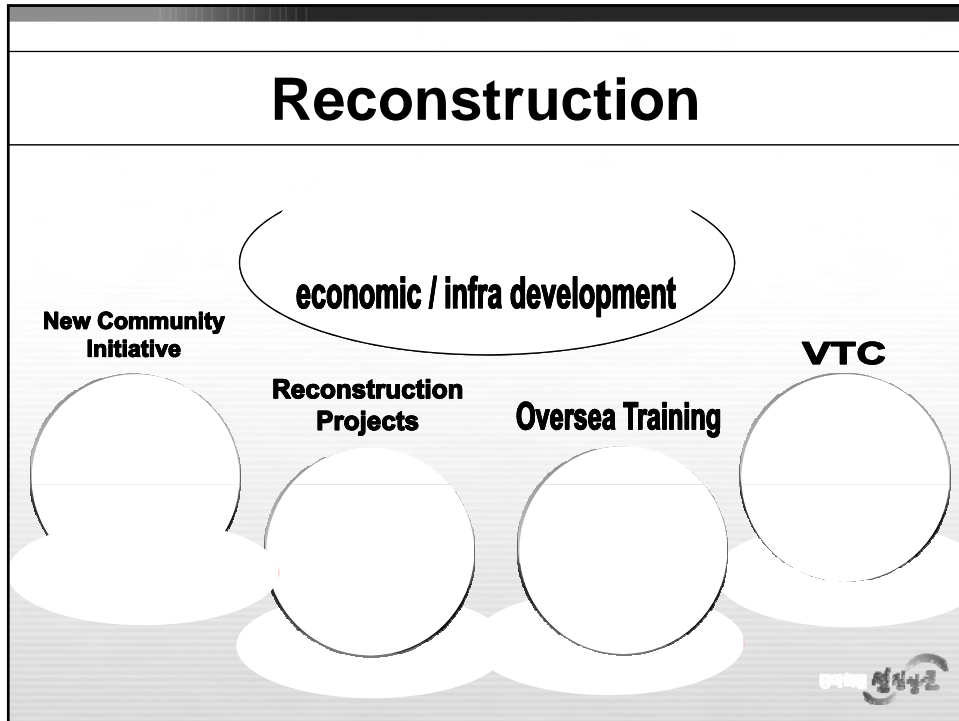

Suggestions (1/2)

● Thorough Preparation before Deployment

- Set up coord. System among GOV, MIL, CIV and NGO

- Organize with elite soldiers and well-organized training
- Understanding of local situation, culture, history and religion
- Publish handbook → Enable to conduct missions immediately
