



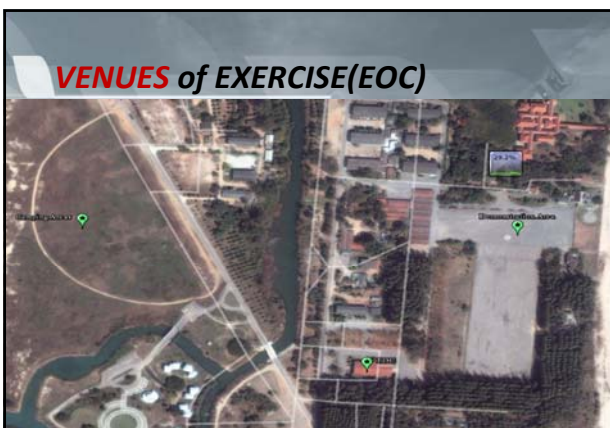
SAR – EXERCISE METHODOLOGY

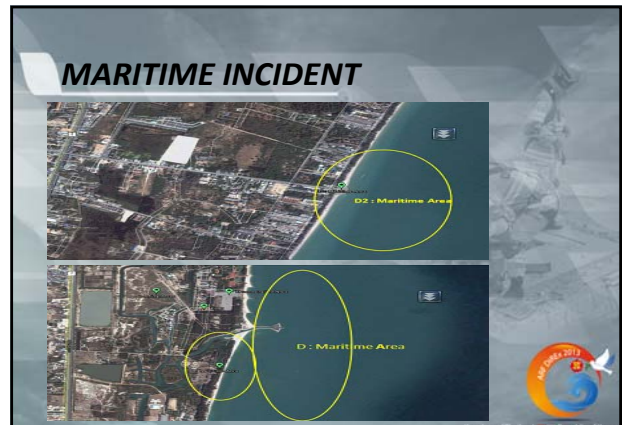
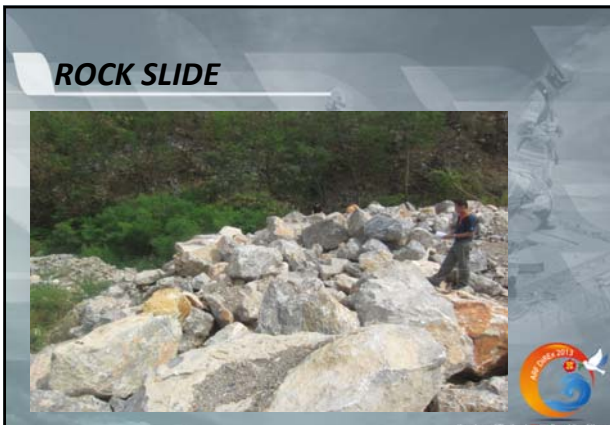
- Exercise control will oversee the entire FTX exercise
- AHA/OSOCC will be set up for the exercise in cooperation with UNOCHA/ASEAN Secretariat.
- The participants will be divided into several groups
- Each group will consists of heavy team and non-heavy team
- Each group will select group leader and he/she will represent the group
- The leader will lead the group from the beginning to the end of Exercise



SAR – EXERCISE METHODOLOGY

- Participants will be requested to attend the AHA/OSOCC meetings.
- Each participants will be assigned missions at the Meeting.
- Grouped participants will be assigned 4 different missions, one after another.
- AAR team members will be joined on the transportation
- AAR team members will possibly ask questions to the SAR members.
- After mission, the group leader should prepare mission completion report for the upcoming AHA/OSOCC meeting



AIR OPERATION

- Concept : Air assets is important for rapid dispatching the Emergency Relief Team
- AIR OPERATION depends on participation Assets
- Combined Air Operation Center will be set up if necessary
- Hua Hin Airport will be use just drop & pick up
- Don Airport can provide Parking Area

- SAR support in Maritime mission
- AIRLIFT from Hua-hin to the affected area
- AIRDROP to isolated area
- MEDICAL EVACUATION
- ILLUMINATION for Night mission of SAR in MARITIME
- FLY-BY for Closing Ceremony

Rock slide	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Rescue Teams & Rescue dogs ▪ High-tech equipment such as an acoustic device, life detector cameras
Maritime incident	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Rescue teams ▪ Sonar, Multi-direction cameras ▪ Medical teams
Air operation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Cargo plane(Air lift, Air drop, SAR) ▪ Helicopters(SAR, Medic evacuation and so on)
