ANNEX 4: Keynote Speech by the Minister of National Defense, Han Min-Gu

The Republic of Korea also hosts the Seoul Defense Dialogue, a vice-minister level meeting, in order to promote peace and stability on the Korean Peninsula and the region.

I am confident that today's ARF National Defense University President Meeting will also develop into a security consultative body that contributes to the peace and trust among nations in the region through wide-ranging dialogue and strengthening of bonds achieved by the active service generals and officials who lead defense policy and education.

Moreover, I look forward to an in-depth discussion on defense education, exchange, and cooperation. Once again, I extend my most heartfelt welcome to all the participants of today's meeting and I wish you a pleasant stay in Korea as you strengthen your bonds. Thank you.
