

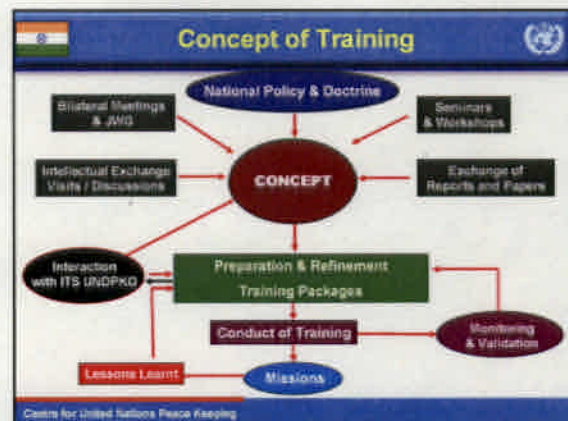
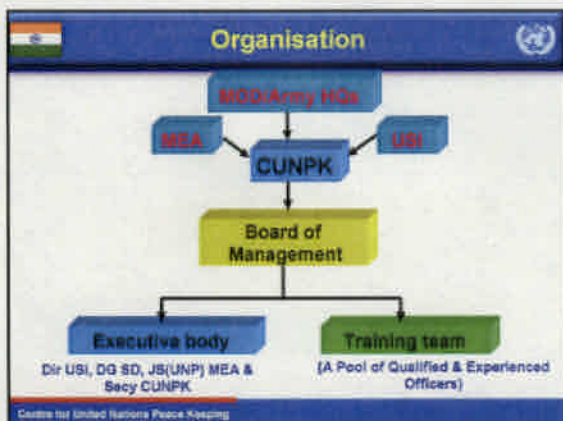
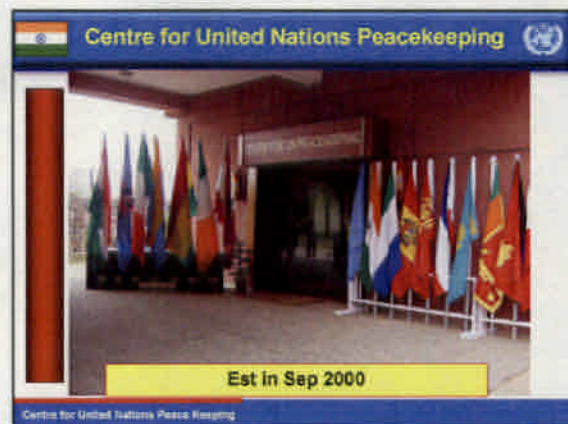

- Act as a repository of Indian experience in the field of UN PKO.

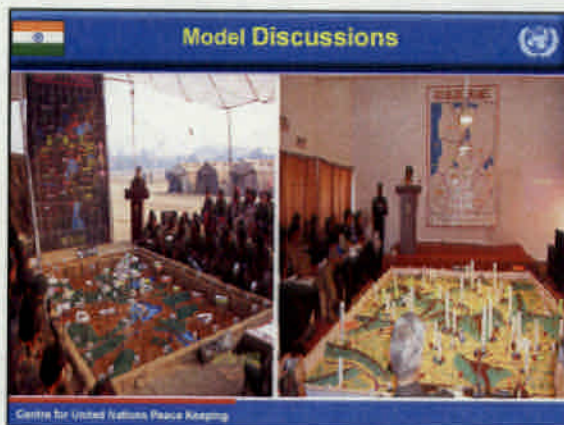

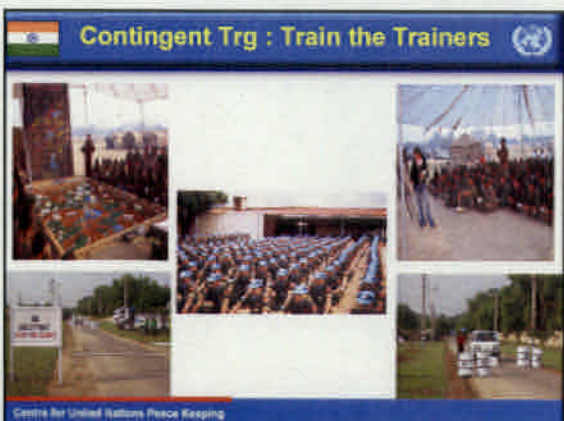

Contingent Trg

- **Procedure for Nomination** → Experienced and seasoned units selected.
- **Orientation Training** → Commences on nomination at the previous formation based on training directive.
- **Pre Induction Training** → Contingents concentrate at Delhi six months in advance for mission oriented training.
- **In mission Training** → On the job training at sub unit level in mission area.

Focus of Mission Orientation Training

- Familiarisation with affected country/ countries, background of the conflict and local culture.
- Familiarisation with UN organisation, UN Charters (Ch VI & VII) and rules of engagement.
- Security council resolutions and mandate related to the mission.
- Human rights and humanitarian assistance.
- Civic action programmes.
- Electoral duties.
- Handling of refugees.


Focus of Mission Orientation Training

- Peacekeeping techniques to include establishment of check points ; patrolling and quick reaction teams ; riot and crowd control ; disarming, demobilisation and creation of DMZ ; investigation, negotiations and liaison drills and ceasefire violations.
- Security of personnel and VAs/VPs.
- Mine awareness, bomb disposal, booby trap and IED threats.
- Driving & Language training.
- Case studies.



In Mission Training

- Assessment of the situation and threat analysis.
- SOFA/ ROE.
- Mine awareness.
- Peacekeeping techniques.
- Contingency plans, including extrication plan.
- Code of conduct.
- SAR missions, cas / medevac.
- Security awareness.
- HIV / AIDs.
- Navigation, including use of GPS.
- Media management.



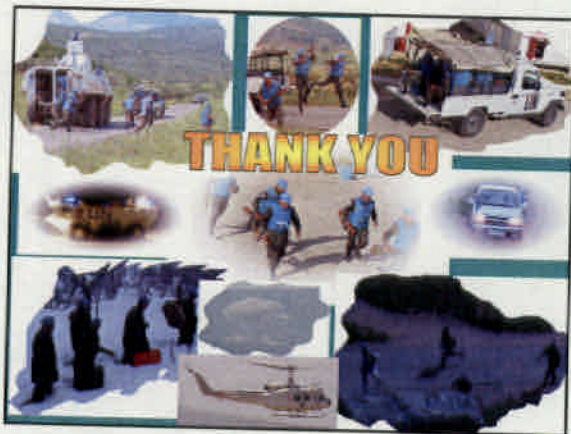
