I. Introduction

1. The Fourth ADMM held on 11 May 2010 has adopted "ADMM Plus: Modalities and Proceedures" which provide a set of principles and broad modalities to guide the catabilithment of the ADMM-Plus as a vecuue for the development of cooperation initiative between ASEAN Member States and Dialogue Partners. This Paper sets out principles and guidance for the stablishnent of EWGs within the ADMM-Plus.




