ASEAN DEFENCE MINISTERS' MEETING-PLUS (ADMM-PLUS): Establishing an Experts' Working Group – Concept Paper

I. Introduction

1. The Fourth ADMM held on 11 May 2010 has adopted "ADMM Plus: Modalities and Procedures" which provide a set of principles and broad modalities to guide the establishment of the ADMM-Plus as a venue for the development of cooperation initiative between ASEAN Member States and Dialogue Partners. Furthermore, the First ADMM-Plus held in Hanoi on 12 October 2010 adopted the Attachment Paper to the "ADMM-Plus: Modalities and Procedures" which task the ADSOM-Plus to establish an Experts' Working Group (EWGs) on defense and security issues of mutual interests. At the time of the adoption of this paper, five areas of cooperation of mutual interests have been agreed upon: (a) Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR); (b) maritime security; (c) military medicine; (d) counter-terrorism; and (e) peacekeeping operations.

2. The EWGs shall establish working principles to encompass consensus-based decision-making at a pace comfortable to all participants, sustain gradual development and shall focus on action-oriented cooperation. This Concept Paper is developed in consistency with the "Outline of the Concept Paper on Establishing an Experts' Working Group". This Paper sets out principles and guidance for the establishment of EWGs within the ADMM-Plus.

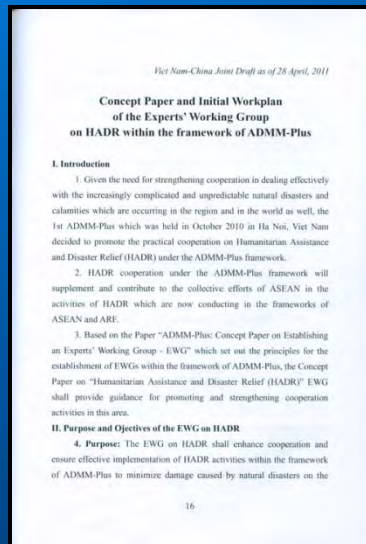

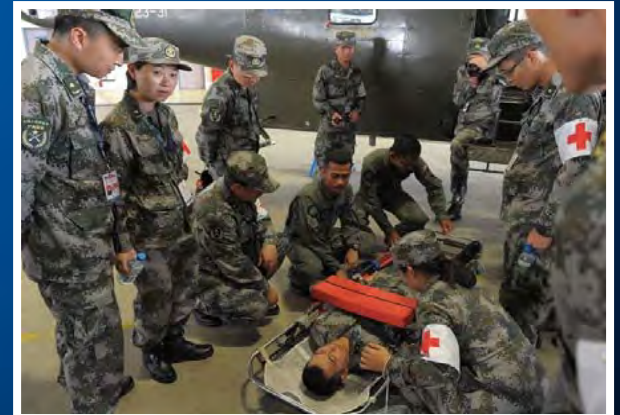

- *Six Search and Rescue Teams.*

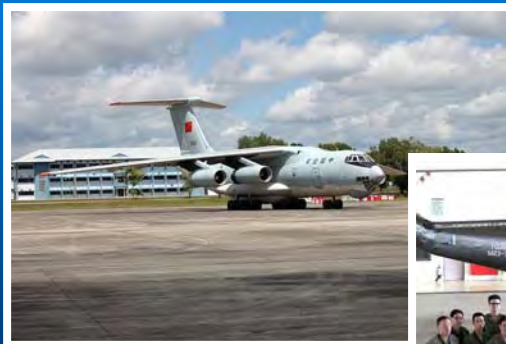

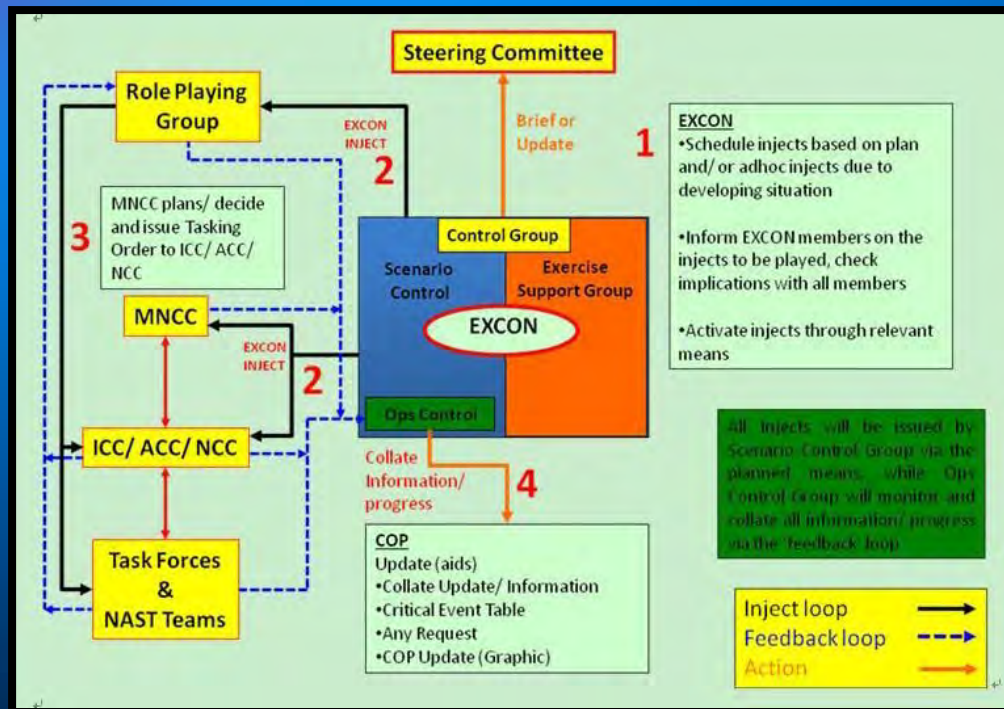

Organization and Coordination

◆ EXCON



EXCON

- Schedule injects based on plan and/or adhoc injects due to developing situation
- Inform EXCON members on the injects to be played, check implications with all members
- Activate injects through relevant means

All injects will be issued by Scenario Control Group via the planned means, while Ops Control Group will monitor and collate all information/progress in the feedback loop.

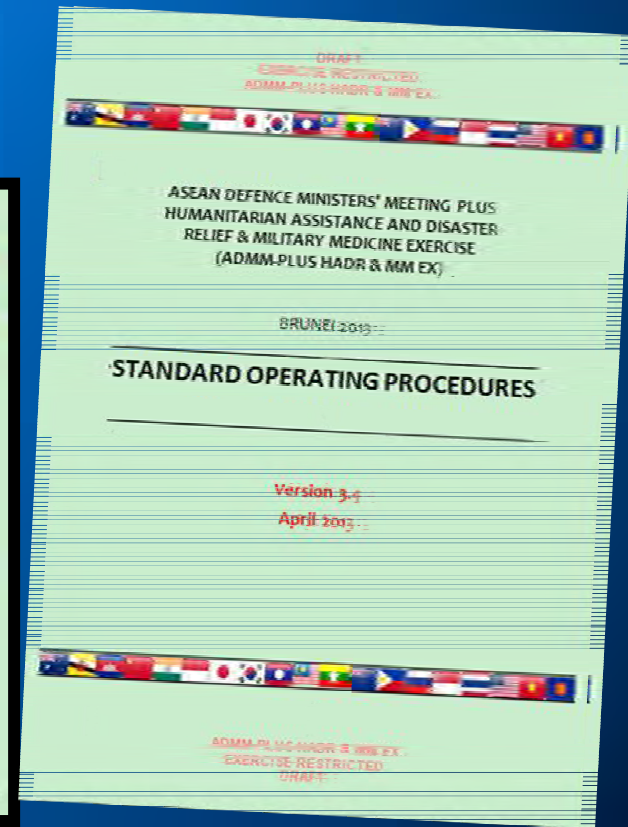
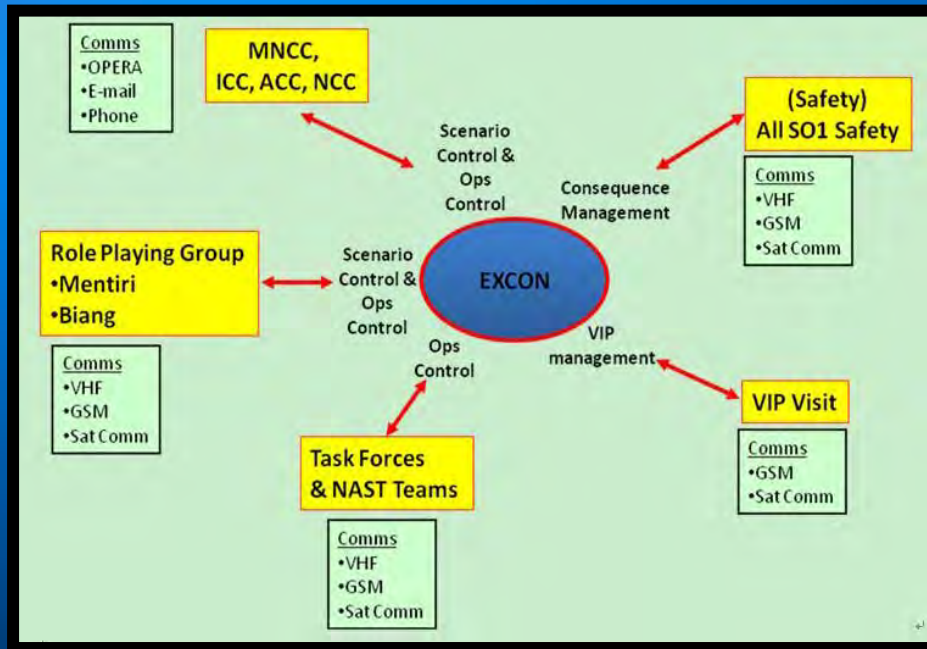

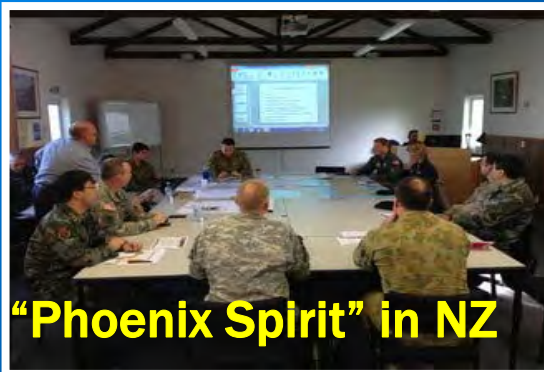
