- Institutionalising AADMER at the national level and promoting cross-sectoral coordination and multistakeholder partnership

ACDM's Focus Areas in 2012



- Reviewing existing policies and legal framework at the national level to ensure that they facilitate the implementation of AADMER
- Implementation, monitoring and evaluation of AADMER Work Programme activities
- Promoting cooperation with partners and ensuring synergies with other related mechanisms such as EAS, ARF, ADMM

- □ Thailand assumed the Chair of ACDM, Viet Nam as Vice Chair
- Discussed urgent issues related to the operationalisation of the AHA Centre
- Convened an open session with key ASEAN
 Dialogue Partners and other ACDM partners







19th Meeting of ACDM



- Reviewed implementation of AADMER and the Work Programme (2010-2015)
- Endorsed the programme proposal on ASEAN
 Disaster Emergency Logistic System
- Reached decisions on cooperation with EAS and military/defense counterpart in disaster management
- Hosting of the ASEAN Regional Disaster Emergency Response Simulation Exercise (ARDEX) 2013 in Viet Nam

1st Meeting of COP to AADMER



- □ Decisions on the operationalisation of AHA Centre
- Endorsed appointment of Executive Director for the AHA Centre for the next three years
- □ Agreement on the annual country contributions for the AHA Centre Fund
- Adoption on the financial rules for the ADMER Fund,
 which is opened for voluntary contributions

1st Meeting of COP to AADMER

- Approval that the ACDM will serve as the main subsidiary body under the COP and will also function as the Governing Board for AHA Centre
- □ Focus of AADMER implementation and AHA Centre, at this stage, should be on natural disasters
- □ Endorsement of the AADMER Partnership Group's programme in view of the important role and contributions of the civil society

1st Meeting of COP to AADMER

□ Reaffirming the ASEAN Leaders' decision in November 2011 that AADMER should remain as the main regional policy backbone and coordinating platforms for disaster management in ASEAN and for other sectors and mechanisms related to disaster management in ASEAN, including ASEAN + 1, ASEAN + 3, EAS, ARF, ADMM and ADMM Plus, to synchronise their policies using AADMER as the common platform to ensure the principles of ASEAN Centrality

- □ 20th Meeting of ACDM in July 2012:
 - Working Group to study the linkage between EAS Work Plan and AADMER Work Programme
 - □ Civil-military cooperation inviting ADSOM Chair & Vice Chair to exchange updates with ACDM
- ASEAN Day on Disaster Management and International Day on Disaster Reduction on 13 Oct
- ASEAN Disaster Awareness Week in the week of November 17 – AHA Centre's first anniversary
- ARDEX 2013 in Viet Nam
