Background

- ➤ Witnessed proliferation cases in 1990s and early 2000s:
- WMD and related materials being transferred to/from states and non-state actors



- Proliferation Security Initiative, launched in 2003 in Krakow, Poland with 11 countries
- To stop WMD shipments of proliferation concern
- To send a strong message of counter-proliferation

Current PSI Endorsers



- > 107 PSI Endorsing countries
- with Palau and the Federated States of Micronesia joining recently

Asia-Pacific Rotational Exercise

- > From 2014, the APER partners have been hosting annual regional PSI exercises in rotation:
- US (Fortune Guard, 2014) → New Zealand (MARU, 2015) →
 Singapore (Deep Sabre, 2016) → Australia (Pacific Protector,
 2017) → Japan (Pacific Shield, 2018) → ROK (Eastern
 Endeavor, 2019)
- > Eastern Endeavor 19 in 10-11 July, in Busan

What PSI is...

- A legally-binding regime that imposes new obligations on countries
- Means to interfere with national implementation
- An operation which goes beyond the scope of international law
- **X** THIS IS NOT TRUE.

Rather,

- A political commitment based on voluntary basis
- An initiative to enhance partner nations' counterproliferation capabilities
- Pursues measures consistent with domestic and international law
