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The Asia-Pacific region is home to 61 percent of the world's population, and s also the region that is affected the most in regards to the human and economic impact caused by natural disasters.

To address this issue the 7th ASEAN Regional Forum Inter-Sessional Meeting held in Helsinki, Finland from 9 to 12 October 2007, stated that a joint exercise is needed to be carried out by ARF member states to address disaster relief in the region.

ARF DiREx is a biennial event which tests civil-military effectiveness and efficiency in its response to large-scale disasters. It also allows testing of existing mechanisms in ASEAN and identifies the issues related to civil-military coordination in the delivery of humanitarian aid at the strategic and operational level through Table Top Exercises (TTX) and tactical level thought its Field Training Exercise (FTX).


