


# **Aids to Navigation**

- •Over 50,000 buoys, fixed markers, and lighthouses

















#### **Deepwater Horizon Response**



- •Fire and explosion on Mobile Offshore Drilling Unit Deepwater Horizon resulted in oil spill
- •First declared Spill of National Significance in U.S. History
- USCG designated Federal
  On Scene Coordinator
- Multiple entities engaged and directed under Incident Command System



# Maritime Operational Threat Response (MOTR)



- •U.S. coordination mechanism to respond to threats that occur in the maritime environment and cross existing lines of jurisdiction or capability
- •All involved parties work together through video teleconferences and telephone calls to discuss the issue and work together to achieve a desired national outcome
- •Used for events such as the pirating of a U.S. flagged vessel or the enactment of bilateral law enforcement agreements
