



Preparation Stage

" Emphasize the importance of advance preparation"

- Monitor situation, gather data, evaluate disaster, and warn units and the public
 - Prepare all resources to be ready
- Coordinate with civil agencies

Operational Stage

- Render assistance in prevention and relief from various danger and disaster






ASEAN Standby Arrangements for Disaster Relief and Emergency Response




















ASEAN Co-ordinating Center for Humanitarian Assistance on disaster management: AHA center

AHA Center in Jakarta, Indonesia

 The Defense Adviser or Military Attaché of each country in Indonesia is to be the Military Liaison Officer at AHA center

Info Exchange And Coordination

 ASEAN military is to provide AHA Centre with a list of assets and resources for HA/DR on voluntary basis

Contribution is to be self-funded

Info Exchange And Coordination

- Preparation Phase
 - Country Profile
 - Airport data /Port data
 - Infrastructure & Communication networks
 - Climate
 - Point of Contacts
 - Interoperability of equipment
 - Exercise and Training, eg. EX TEMPEST EXPRESS
 - Cultural and Social Awareness

Info Exchange And Coordination

- Recovery Phase
 - -Diplomatic Clearance
 - –Logistic needs
 - -Onward movement plan
 - –Host nation identifies HA/DR requirements
 - -Handover and Exit arrangements

Combined Exercises

- Types of Exercises
 - Bilateral continue as usual.
 - Multilateral to be conducted preliminary to ARDEX annually.
 - All military exercises to support civilian needs (exercise simulation in consultation with civilian representative).
